Commission reports continued:

International Relations: (Ann Schuette, Trinity College, Washington, D.C.) The national commission is continuing attempts to coordinate activities among member colleges and to foster the establishment of regional commissions. They have continued to publish Brief International Views. Its theme this year is the trouble spots throughout the world. Issues so far have treated of the Balkans, the Far East and South America. The release has been complimented by several non-sectarian schools.

Inter-Racial Relations: (Jane Crowley, Manhattanville College) The commission is endeavoring to focus interest on inter-racial justice by sponsoring an inter-racial justice week. As background to this a questionnaire has been sent to Catholic colleges asking: 1) Is there a negro student attending the school? 2) What is their experience with regard to any in attendance? 3) If there is none, could there be one? Fifty questionnaires out of a hundred have been returned. Inter-racial Week plans are complete.

Liturgy: (St. John's University, Collegeville, Minn.)

Mariology: (Regina Daley, College of St. Rose, Albany, N.Y.) The commission has sent out a release on Our Lady of Fatima. The release was mentioned in the September outline of the Sodality and requests have come in from all over the country from high schools and parishes. Two books on Our Lady by students of St. Rose's are to be published by St. Anthony's Guild Press. The commission is presently conducting two radio programs; a Rosary Hour and a Catholic Family Hour. Mr. Haffert whose chief interest is to propagate devotion to the scapular has offered through them to speak to any member college. The Legion of Mary is established on campus. Booklets are being prepared on Our Lady of Fatima and Our Lady of LaSalette. There are three committees operating in the college, devoting themselves severally to Our Lady in Music, Our Lady in Poetry and Our Lady in Art. They have also issued a release on DeMontfort's True Devotion, the Scapular and Our Lady's Protection in Traveling.
